Comments:

Throughput for week 12 was 358,665 tonnes of cane in a week that included a cleaning intermission at Kalamia Mill.

There were also unscheduled stops at Invicta, Kalamia and Pioneer mills to carry out repairs.

Inkerman Mill had its highest throughput for the season to date with 92,764 tonnes processed for the week. Well, done to all involved.

Average weekly CCS was 15.49, which is 0.67 of a unit above budget.

The highest CCS recorded for the week was 18.00 from a rake of mixed second ratoon cane supplied from the Mulgrave productivity district.

As the season progresses past the halfway mark, we're urging people to remain vigilant around our cane rail network.

Trains cannot swerve and they cannot stop quickly. It is up to drivers, cyclists and pedestrians to give way at rail crossings. Always obey crossing signals, warning lights and signage, and never attempt to cross if a train is approaching.

Please remember to use your train brain and always give way to cane trains.
