Throughput for week 13 was more than 380,500 tonnes of cane in a week that included cleaning intermissions at Invicta and Pioneer mills.

There were also unscheduled stops at Kalamia Mill to carry out repairs.

Inkerman Mill had another good week with more than 90,000 tonnes processed for the week. Well done to all involved.

Average weekly CCS was 15.39, which is 0.49 of a unit above budget.

The highest CCS recorded for the week was 18.00 from a rake of Q208 plant cane supplied from the Fredericksfield productivity district.
