Comments:

The Burdekin mills have now processed more than 5M tonnes of cane.

Throughput for week 14 was more than 370,000 tonnes of cane in a week that included a cleaning intermission at Inkerman Mill.

There were also unscheduled stops at Kalamia and Pioneer mills to carry out repairs.

Average weekly CCS was 15.55, which is 0.55 of a unit above budget.

The highest CCS recorded for the week was 18.60 from a rake of Q240 fourth ratoon cane supplied from the Stockham Road productivity district.

Harvesting operators are again reminded to follow siding procedures when delivering or collecting bins. These procedures are designed to safeguard all users and maintain the efficient operation of our sidings.

Parents and carers are asked to remind children to stay away from the cane railway network. Members of the public are urged to report any suspicious activity around our cane rail line to the police.
