Comments:

Invicta Mill has passed the two million tonnes crushed milestone, and the Burdekin mills have now processed a total of 5.38M tonnes of cane.

This puts the Burdekin region at the 75 per cent mark for the 2026 season.

Throughput for week 15 was more than 375,000 tonnes of cane in a week that included two cleaning intermissions at Invicta Mill.

Pioneer Mill had a strong week with more than 82,000 tonnes of cane processed – its highest weekly throughput for the season to date.

There were unscheduled stops at Kalamia, Inkerman and Pioneer mills to carry out repairs.

Average weekly CCS was 15.49, which is 0.45 of a unit above budget.

The highest CCS recorded for the week was 17.90 from a rake of Q240 plant cane and Q240 first ratoon supplied from the Leichhardt and Mulgrave productivity district respectively.

With school holidays coming up, parents and carers are asked to remind children to stay away from the cane railway network.

Members of the public are urged to report any suspicious activity around our cane rail line to the police.
