Comments:

Close to 200,000 tonnes of cane were processed for the week, bringing the season-to-date total to 1.38M tonnes.

The average weekly CCS was 13.85 units, bringing the season-to-date figure to 13.29.

Another week of mainly clear weather has contributed to good harvesting conditions and solid factory throughput.

The western line congestion is impacting bin delivery and pick-up times, which in turn puts pressure on our locomotive schedule. Please communicate with the Traffic Office as the number of groups that can be serviced along this line is limited.

Last week's haulout collision continues to be a safety focus for this week. While there were no injuries, the learnings from the event will be communicated to increase awareness.

Remember that cane trains can't swerve or stop quickly. Please approach all crossings with caution, obey all signs and signals, and always give way to cane trains.
