Comments:

More than 184,000 tonnes of cane were processed for the week, bringing the season-to-date total to 1.76M tonnes.

The average weekly CCS has remained above budget at 14.03 units, lifting the season-to-date CCS to 13.45.

A run of dry weather has supported good harvesting conditions. Thank you to those harvesting operators who are maintaining regular communication with the traffic office as we manage the migration of harvesting groups and the associated pressure on line loading.

Our Cane Supply and Transport operations team is working hard to manage logistical challenges and ensure we work closely with groups to keep our cane bins moving.

As we approach the halfway mark to the season, we're reminding members of the public to remain vigilant around our cane rail network. Please also report any unsafe behaviour to the police.

Remember that cane trains can't swerve or stop quickly. Please approach all crossings with caution, obey all signs and signals, and always give way to cane trains.
