Comments:

A strong result this week with more than 201,800 tonnes of cane processed for the week, bringing the season-to-date total to 1.97M tonnes.

The average weekly CCS has remained above budget at 13.98 units, lifting the season-to-date CCS to 13.50.

Similar to last week, the run of dry weather has supported good harvesting conditions.

As we near the halfway mark for the 2026 season, I'd like to congratulate our Cane Supply and Operations teams for achieving such a good result this week.

Thanks also to the harvesting sector for maintaining good communication with the traffic office, as this has enabled us to optimise our locomotive schedule and bin deliveries.

Another reminder to the public to remain vigilant around our cane rail network and to please report any unsafe behaviour to the police.

Remember that cane trains can't swerve or stop quickly. Please approach all crossings with caution, obey all signs and signals, and always give way to cane trains.
