Comments:

We officially passed the halfway mark this week thanks to the efforts from the harvesting sector, our transport team and the Herbert mills.

More than 188,00 tonnes of cane were processed for the week, bringing the season-to-date total to 2.15M tonnes.

The average weekly CCS has remained above budget at 14.08 units, lifting the season-to-date CCS to 13.55.

Rain at the start of the week impacted supply, with a stop to harvesting in some areas.

Victoria Mill had a maintenance clean on B side while Macknade crews took advantage of the wet weather stop and completed small maintenance tasks.

We ask the public to remain vigilant around our cane rail network and to please report any unsafe behaviour to the police.

Remember that cane trains can't swerve or stop quickly. Please approach all crossings with caution, obey all signs and signals, and always give way to cane trains.
