Comments:

Just over 191,000 of cane was processed for the week, bringing the season-to-date total to 2.35M tonnes.

The average weekly CCS has again tracked above budget at 14.43 units, lifting the season-to-date CCS to 13.63.

Macknade Mill had a cleaning intermission on Tuesday 8th September. Victoria Mill crews completed minor maintenance jobs throughout the week to avoid a full 12-hour stop on Thursday.

Our traffic team is assisting with group migration requests where possible, however some line loading restrictions were activated to avoid further delays with bin deliveries and congestion.

We ask the public to remain vigilant around our cane rail network and to please report any unsafe behaviour to the police.

Remember that cane trains can't swerve or stop quickly. Please approach all crossings with caution, obey all signs and signals, and always give way to cane trains.
