Comments

Proserpine Mill processed close to 75,700 tonnes of cane for the week. This was below budget for the week due to a significant bagasse choke. Our season to date total is now just over 647,893 tonnes.

Average weekly CCS came in above budget, at 14.27 units.

The highest weekly CCS sample for the week was 17.08 units, from a rake of Q208 ratoon cane in the Elaroo District.

We're appealing to members of the public to use their train brain after reports of a driver failing to give way to an approaching cane train and narrowly avoiding a collision.

The incident serves as a timely reminder of the importance of being vigilant around rail crossings, obeying all signs and signals, and always giving way to cane trains.

Our cane trains work around the clock, seven days a week, so please continue to use your train brain and always take care around the cane rail network.
