#### Comments:

Plane Creek Mill crushed 58,582 tonnes of cane for the week, bringing the season total to more than 141,000 tonnes.

The factory performed well over the week with consistent crush rates and reasonable reliability.

Overnight rain on Friday and into Saturday caused significant disruption to the harvesting sector. A small number of harvesters were able to supply cane on Saturday morning. However, all harvesters ceased operations by late morning.

The remaining cane was crushed by late afternoon on Saturday, before the mill commenced a factory chemical clean.

The average weekly CCS increased by 0.68 of a unit, taking the season-to-date CCS figure to 12.04 units.

The highest CCS was 14.1 from a rake of KQ228 3<sup>rd</sup> ratoon from the Ilbilbie productivity district.

Despite the current wet weather disruption, cane trains may still be moving around the district. With school holidays still under way, parents and carers are urged to speak to their children about the need to stay well away from cane trains, cane bins and cane rail corridors.
