Consistent crushing rates saw Plane Creek Mill achieve a weekly throughput total of more than 65,000 tonnes of cane – the highest for the season to date.

There was a marginal improvement in CCS of 0.23 of a unit over the previous week, taking the season-to-date CCS to just under 12 units.

The highest CCS recorded for the week was 14.90 from a rake of Q208 1R from the Dawlish productivity district.

This week, there will be a 12-hour scheduled cleaning intermission on Tuesday 2 August.

Cane growers are encouraged to advise the field office of areas harvested for seed now that planting operations have commenced.

With crushing operations back in full swing, remember to use your train brain and always give way to cane trains.
