Comments:

A total of 56,634 tonnes of cane was crushed for the week, taking the season total to more than 750,000 tonnes.

The 50 per cent milestone was reached late on Saturday evening.

The mill resumed crushing late on Sunday evening following storms on Saturday afternoon that affected a number of harvesting groups.

The production team used the cane supply shortfall early in the week to bring forward a planned stoppage, carrying out a factory clean on Sunday and maintenance work on Monday.

Average weekly CCS was 13.77, down from 14.05 units the previous week. The average bin weight for the week dropped to 3.78 tonnes

The highest CCS was 15.9 units from a rake of SRA9 plant from the Yukon productivity district.
