#### Comments:

Widespread rain on Sunday night significantly impacted cane supply and brought operations to a halt on Monday morning.

Showers and drizzle persisted for the bulk of the week, with some areas in the northern parts of the supply district recording more than 100mm of rain.

As a result, only 10,587 tonnes of cane was processed for the week, bringing the season total to just over 229,000 tonnes.

Crews took the opportunity to undertake mill maintenance during the forced downtime.

Average weekly CCS reduced by a noticeable 0.57 units from the previous week. This is likely to be attributed to an increase in the percentage of stand-over supplied.

The highest CCS was 15.50 units from a rake of Q183 1<sup>st</sup> Ratoon from the Mt Christian productivity district.
