Comments:

Plane Creek Mill processed 36,491 tonnes of cane for the week – pushing past the 1M tonne milestone on Friday evening.

Pre-dawn storms and showers occurred over most of the supply district on Monday, significantly impacting cane supply and causing a stop to operations on Tuesday.

Harvesting recommenced on Thursday morning and production resumed later that evening.

There was a slight decrease in CCS levels of 0.36 of a unit from the previous week, due to the adverse impact of wet weather.

The highest CCS for the week was shared between a rake of Q183 3R from the Carmila West productivity area and a rake of Q208 3R from the Westhill productivity area – with a CCS of 17.60 units.
