#### Comments:

Plane Creek Mill processed 47,234 tonnes of cane for the week, bringing the season total to just over 234,000 tonnes.

The shredder master turbine failed on Sunday afternoon, resulting in the factory crushing on the slave turbine for the week at reduced rates. Repairs are planned for this coming weekend.

Average CCS dropped by 0.04 of a unit over the previous week, closing out at 13.09 units. Standover cane once again made up 24 per cent of the week's cane supply.

The highest CCS honour for the week was shared between a rake of KQ228 1R from the Mt Christian productivity area and another rake of KQ228 4R from the Yukon productivity area – both with a CCS of 16.2 units.

Locomotive drivers have reported that members of the public are loitering close to the track in and around the town rail corridor.
