#### Comments:

Plane Creek Mill processed about 50,400 tonnes of cane for the week, bringing the season-to-date total to just over 1,178,000 tonnes.

Average CCS declined by 1.13 of a unit over the previous week, closing out at 12.61 units. The year-to-date average is now sitting at 14.07 units.

Standover cane made up approximately five per cent of the week's cane supply.

The highest CCS honour for the week was a rake of Q183 second ratoon from the West Hill productivity area with a CCS of 15.80 units.

With school holidays under way, we ask parents and carers to remind children that cane trains will continue to operate into January this season. Ensure children do not play on or near our cane rail network.

Please keep your train brain switched on. Be alert, stay off our rail network and always give way to cane trains.
