#### Comments:

Plane Creek Mill processed 18,285 tonnes of cane for the week, bringing the season-to-date total to just under 1,252,000 tonnes.

Average CCS declined by 1.36 of a unit over the previous week, closing out at 10.39 units. The year-to-date average is now sitting at 13.92 units.

Standover cane made up approximately three per cent of the week's cane supply.

The highest CCS honour for the week was a rake of Q183 6R from the Carmila West productivity area with a CCS of 14.00 units.

Subject to weather and mill performance, harvesting operations at Plane Creek are currently expected to finish on Thursday 9 January 2025.

This advice will be reviewed regularly and any changes advertised through Wilmar Sugar's GrowerWeb and this weekly production report.

As we enter the final weeks of the 2024 season, members of the public are reminded to stay alert around our cane rail network.

Remember to approach all level crossings with caution and always give way to cane trains.
