Comments:

Plane Creek Mill processed 15,703 tonnes of cane for the week, bringing the season-to-date total to just under 1.27M tonnes.

Average CCS declined by 0.76 of a unit over the previous week, closing out at 9.63 units. The year-to-date average is now sitting at 13.87 units.

The highest CCS honour for the week was a rake of Q183 6R from the Yukon productivity area with a CCS of 13.40 units.

Subject to weather and mill performance, harvesting operations at Plane Creek are currently expected to finish on Thursday 9 January 2025.
