#### Comments:

Plane Creek Mill processed just over 28,000 tonnes of cane for the week, bringing the season total to just over 164,000 tonnes.

Showery conditions continued to impede harvesting operations in the first half of the week. The mill ceased operations on Sunday due to a shortage of cane and restarted on Thursday morning.

Average weekly CCS came in at 12.49 units, with bin weights remaining around the 3.88T range

Standover cane made up 11 per cent of the week's cane supply.

The highest CCS honour for the week was a rake of Q228 first ratoon cane from the Carmila West productivity area with a CCS of 15.45 units.
