Comments:

Plane Creek Mill processed just under 56,700 tonnes of cane for the week, bringing the season total to just under 276,000 tonnes.

Factory throughput is improving steadily as paddocks continue dry out.

The mill stopped for shredder tips on Saturday followed by a broken gear shaft on No 4 Mill on Saturday afternoon.

Average weekly CCS came in at 12.30 units, with bin weights steadily improving from the previous week to average 3.8 tonnes.

Standover cane made up almost 36 per cent of the week's cane supply. High proportions of standover cane will impede factory throughput and crushing rate.

The highest CCS honour for the week was a rake of Q183 replant cane from the Dawlish productivity area with a CCS of 15.60 units.
