Comments:

Plane Creek Mill processed just over 64,300 tonnes of cane for the week and passed the 1 million tonnes milestone.

The season-to-date total is now just over 1,055,500 tonnes and represents 75 per cent of the estimated crop.

Average weekly CCS jumped to 15.80 units – an increase of 0.16 on the previous week. The season average is now sitting on 13.69.

Average bin weights were once again respectable at 3.91 tonnes for the week.

Standover cane decreased to just over two per cent of the week's cane supply.

The highest CCS honour for the week was a rake of Q183 re-plant cane from the Bollingbroke productivity area with a CCS of 18.20.

This week, the factory will stop for a 12-hour scheduled cleaning intermission on Tuesday.

With the season coming to progressing, I'd like to remind pedestrians not to linger near any part of the rail network and only cross the line at designated crossings.

Remember our locos are towing heavy loads and can take up to 1km to come to a complete stop.
