#### Comments:

Plane Creek Mill processed just over 53,000 tonnes of cane for the week, bringing the season-to-date total to 1.21M tonnes.

Average weekly CCS dropped by 0.36 of a unit to 14.89. The decrease was due to thunderstorms across the district early in the week. The season average is now sitting at 13.90.

Average bin weights also dipped to 3.77 tonnes for the week due to the wet field conditions

Standover cane made up just over five per cent of the week's cane supply.

The highest CCS honour for the week was a rake of Q208 sixth ratoon cane from the Koumala productivity area with a CCS of 17.50.

We once again remind parents and caregivers to talk to children about the dangers of playing on or around our cane rail network

Remember to approach all level crossings with caution and always give way to cane trains.
