Comments:

Plane Creek Mill processed just over 50,000 tonnes of cane for the week, bringing the season-to-date total to just over 1.26M tonnes.

Average weekly CCS dropped by 0.77 of a unit to 14.06. The decrease was again due to thunderstorms across the district during the week. The season average is now sitting at 13.91.

Average bin weights dipped to 3.72 tonnes for the week due to the continuing wet field conditions.

Standover cane made up just over six per cent of the week's cane supply.

The highest CCS honour for the week was a rake of Q208 fifth ratoon cane from the Bollingbroke productivity area with a CCS of 16.50.

Subject to weather and mill performance, harvesting operations at Plane Creek are currently expected to finish on Wednesday 26 November 2025.

This advice will be reviewed regularly and any changes advertised through Wilmar Sugar's GrowerWeb and this weekly production report.

As we enter the final weeks of the 2025 season, members of the public are reminded to stay alert around our cane rail network.

Remember to approach all level crossings with caution and always give way to cane trains.
