Comments:

Plane Creek Mill processed just over 42,000 tonnes of cane for the week, bringing the season-to-date total to just over 1.3M tonnes.

The major cause of lost time for the week was a governor failure on No. 5 Mill turbine.

Average weekly CCS dropped by 0.64 of a unit to 13.42. The decrease was again due to rain across the district during the week. The season average is now sitting at 13.89.

Average bin weights dipped to 3.66 tonnes for the week due to the continuing wet field conditions.

Standover cane made up just over five per cent of the week's cane supply.

The highest CCS honour for the week was a rake of Q208 sixth ratoon cane from the Koumala productivity area with a CCS of 16.80.

The last day of harvest for the Plane Creek Mill will be Wednesday, 26 November 2025.
