Plane Creek Mill's 2026 production season commenced with harvesting on Tuesday 2 June and the mill tipping the first bin at 2am on Wednesday 3 June.

Despite some settling in issues during the early part of the week, daily factory throughput improved before the weekend.

The average bin weight was a healthy 4.06 tonnes, while average weekly CCS was 13.41 units.

The highest CCS for the week was 15.70, from a rake of Q228 first ratoon in the Ilbilbie productivity district.
