#### Comments:

Plane Creek Mill processed just over 52,100 tonnes of cane for the week, bringing the season total to more than 118,000 tonnes.

Showers again hindered some harvesting operations across the district causing cane supply shortfalls late in the week.

A bin derailment at Onooie also caused supply gaps early in the week.

Average weekly CCS came in at 13.63 units, and bin weights dipped slightly from the previous week to average 3.96 tonnes.

The highest CCS honour for the week went to a rake of SRA9 first ratoon cane from the Mount Christian productivity area, with a CCS of 16.40 units.

With the season well under way, I'd like to remind pedestrians not to linger near any part of the cane rail network and only cross the line at designated crossings.

Remember our locos are towing heavy loads and can take up to 1km to come to a complete stop.
