Plane Creek Mill processed just over 48,600 tonnes of cane for the week, bringing the season total to more than 230,600 tonnes.

The factory undertook a 12-hour cleaning intermission early in the week.

Average weekly CCS came in at 14.35 units, and bin weights slipped slightly from the previous week to average 3.95 tonnes.

The highest CCS honour went to a rake of Q250 second ratoon cane from the Carmila West productivity area, with a CCS of 16.60 units.
