Comments:

Plane Creek Mill processed just over 58,800 tonnes of cane for the week, bringing the season total to just under 465,000 tonnes.

Average weekly CCS came in at 14.98 units – a decrease of 0.42 of a unit on the previous week.

Bin weights decreased on the previous week, to average 3.97 tonnes.

The highest CCS honours for the week went to a rake of Q240 first ratoon cane from the Koumala productivity area with a CCS of 17.60 units.
