Plane Creek Mill processed just shy of 48,900 tonnes of cane for the week, bringing the season total to more than 843,000 tonnes.

Average weekly CCS came in at 16.22 units – an increase of 0.32 of a unit on the previous week.

Bin weights remained constant at 4 tonnes for the week.

Dry weather continued throughout the district, creating ideal harvesting conditions.

The highest CCS honours for the week was a rake of Q240 plant cane from the Koumala productivity area with a CCS of 18.40 units.

A reminder to all road users that cane trains can't swerve and they can't stop quickly. Use your train brain and always give way to cane trains.
