#### Comments:

Plane Creek Mill's 2020 crushing season commenced at 10.41am on Tuesday 23 June.

The mill experienced very few mechanical and production issues during its first week of operation.

However, wet ground conditions impacted harvesting operations and cane supply. This resulted in slower crush rates and some cane supply stoppages.

Average weekly CCS was 11.55. The average bin weight was 3.78 tonnes.

Road users in the district may have noticed Wilmar's cane train safety billboards. The key message is: 'Use your train brain. Be cane train smart'.

That means to always be on the lookout for cane trains, obey all signs and signals at cane railway crossings, and always give way to cane trains.

With school holidays now under way, parents and carers should remind their children of the dangers of playing on or near the cane rail network.
