#### Comments:

Increased crushing rates and a welcome improvement in bin weights saw Plane Creek Mill crush nearly 70,000 tonnes of cane for the week – the highest weekly throughput for the season.

There was a marginal improvement in CCS of 0.22 a unit over the previous week, taking the season-to-date CCS to just under 13 units.

The highest CCS was 16.60 from a rake of Q252 2<sup>nd</sup> ratoon from the Dawlish productivity district. This is the second week running that the top CCS has come from the Dawlish area.

This week, there will be a 12-hour scheduled cleaning intermission on Wednesday 26 August.

Cane growers are encouraged to advise the field office of areas harvested for seed now that planting operations are well under way.
