#### Comments:

Plane Creek Mill has now passed the halfway mark for the 2020 season.

The factory crushed just under 70,000 tonnes of cane for the week to bring the season total to 661,525 tonnes.

The 50 per cent milestone of 625,000 tonnes was achieved on Wednesday.

The only major stop during the week was on Sunday night when cane supply was impacted by a derailment of empty bins.

CCS edged higher by 0.12 of a unit over the previous week and the season to date CCS closed out at 13.38.

This week, there is a 12-hour cleaning intermission planned for Thursday, 17 September.

With school holidays beginning on Friday 18 September, parents are urged to warn their children of the dangers of playing near cane railway lines.
