Just over 63,000 tonnes of cane were crushed for the week, bringing the season total to almost 725,000 tonnes.

This was a good weekly throughput, given there was a 12-hour planned maintenance stop and a seven-hour stoppage to replace a failed motor on the PC elevator.

CCS figures improved by 0.33 of a unit over the previous week, to average 14.79 units.

The season to date CCS closed out at 13.5 units.

The highest CCS was 16.90 from a rake of Q208 1st ratoon from the Westhill productivity district.
