Comments:

Plane Creek Mill achieved good throughput for the week with a total of 67,680 tonnes crushed. A two-hour unplanned shredder tip change was the longest stop for the week.

CCS figures made a modest 0.03 of a unit improvement over the previous week, to average 14.86 units.

The season to date CCS closed out at 13.62 units.

The highest CCS was 17.50 from a rake of Q208 1st ratoon from the Plane Creek productivity district.

Weather conditions remain favourable for harvesting, although there were isolated reports of heavy rain in the Ilbilbie and Mt Christian districts on Thursday, with up to 24mm of rain recorded.

There will be a 24-hour factory stop, commencing on Wednesday evening, to undertake #3 boiler grate repairs. During the stoppage, the opportunity will be taken to conduct a factory chemical clean, one week ahead of schedule.
