#### Comments:

Plane Creek Mill passed the one million tonnes crushed milestone during the week.

The mill has now processed 84 per cent of the revised total crop of 1.22 million tonnes.

Just over 61,000 tonnes of cane were crushed for the week.

This was a good weekly throughput, given there was a 12-hour planned maintenance stop and a disruption to cane supply due to a grass fire on land adjacent to Wilmar Sugar's cane storage yard at Shannon's Flat.

CCS figures edged slightly higher by 0.02 of a unit over the previous week, to average 15.83 units.

It pushed the season to date CCS past 14 units for the first time this year, closing out at 14.07 units.

The highest CCS was 18.4 units from a rake of Q208 Plant from the Yucan productivity district.
