Comments:

Plane Creek Mill crushed more than 58,000 tonnes of cane for the week. That brought the season-to-date total to just under 1.1 million tonnes, which represents 89 per cent of the forecast 1.22 million tonne crop.

Scattered showers and thunderstorms earlier in the week disrupted harvesting operations, and this contributed to the reduced weekly throughput.

Average weekly CCS was 15.11, down from 15.83 units the previous week. The average bin weight for the week dropped to 3.77 tonnes.

The highest CCS for the week was 18.4 units from a rake of Q240 Plant in the Westhill productivity district.

Subject to weather and mill performance, harvesting operations at Plane Creek are currently expected to finish on Tuesday 17 November.
