Comments:

Plane Creek Mill crushed more than 43,000 tonnes of cane for the week. That brought the season-to-date total to just under 1.2 million tonnes, which represents 97 per cent of the forecast 1.22 million tonne crop.

Weekly throughput was down, mainly due to a bin derailment impacting cane supply early in the week.

Subject to weather and mill performance, Plane Creek Mill is due to complete crushing operations on Saturday, 21 November.

Average bin weight and CCS declined slightly from the previous week.

The highest CCS for the week was a rake of Mixed 3R from the Westhill productivity area with a CCS of 17.75.

Please be aware that even though crushing is drawing to a close, there will still be activity on our rail network with the maintenance season commencing.
