#### Comments:

Plane Creek Mill crushed 48,381 tonnes of cane in the final week of the 2020 season. That brought the season total to just over 1.23 million tonnes, which was slightly down on the original forecast due to the dry conditions during key periods of the growing season.

Crushing operations were completed at 10.53pm on Friday, 20 November.

CCS slipped slightly from the previous week due to recent rainfall events. The final season CCS was 14.23 units.

The highest CCS honour for the week was shared between a rake of Q183 7R from the Plane Creek productivity area and a rake of Q240 1R from the Yukan productivity area, both with a CCS of 16.9.

I would like to acknowledge the effort that was put in by growers, harvesting contractors and Wilmar employees in completing this year's crush. I'd also like to wish everybody a happy and safe Christmas and New Year period.
