#### Comments:

Plane Creek Mill's 2021 crushing season commenced at 10.05am on Tuesday 15 June.

The factory settled in well, with very few mechanical or production issues during the first week of operation.

However, widespread rain and showers in the middle of the week impacted harvesting operations. This resulted in reduced crush rates and a lengthy cane supply stoppage.

The average bin weight was 3.92 tonnes. Average weekly CCS was 11.93.

The highest CCS for the week was 15.50, from a rake of Q208 first ratoon in the Dawlish productivity district.

Road users in the district may have noticed Wilmar's cane train safety billboards. The key message is: 'Use your train brain. Give way to cane trains.'

That means to always be on the lookout for cane trains, obey all signs and signals at cane railway crossings, and always give way to cane trains.
