#### Comments:

Plane Creek Mill crushed just over 67,500 tonnes of cane for the week, bringing the season total more than 445,000 tonnes.

The major cause of lost time for the week was an empty bin derailment on the Koumala line on Tuesday morning.

There was a modest 0.35 of unit improvement in CCS over the previous week, taking the season-to-date CCS to 13.34 units.

The highest CCS was 17.00 units from a rake of Q183 Plant from the Mainline productivity district.

The Plane Creek crop continues to exceed the original estimate by more than seven per cent. As a result, the Plane Creek crop estimate has been revised upwards by 50,000 tonnes to 1.35 million tonnes.
