Comments:

Just over 61,000 tonnes of cane was processed for the week, bringing the season total to almost 568,000 tonnes.

This was a reasonable weekly throughput, given there was a 14-hour planned maintenance stop on Tuesday.

CCS figures improved by 0.47 of a unit over the previous week, to average 14.95 units.

The highest CCS was 16.90 units from a rake of Q183 Plant from the Dawlish productivity district.

Locomotive crews are reporting an alarming number of near hits involving motorists failing to stop at cane rail crossings, including those with flashing lights.

This practice is illegal and extremely dangerous. Footage from loco-mounted cameras is being passed on to police.

Please remember to use your train brain, obey all signs and signals, and always give way to cane trains.
