Plane Creek Mill resumed crushing on Sunday afternoon following a rain event that stopped harvesting for several days.

A total of 53,549 tonnes of cane was crushed for the week, taking the season total to just below 700,000 tonnes.

The 50 per cent milestone was reached on Friday evening.

There was a welcome improvement in CCS of 0.35 of a unit over the previous week, taking the season-to-date CCS to just under 14 units.

The highest CCS recorded for the week was 17.30 from a rake of Q208 2R in the Dawlish productivity district.

With school holidays starting on Friday 17 September, we ask parents, carers and teachers to remind children about the dangers of playing on or around our cane rail network.
