Plane Creek Mill crushed just shy of 54,000 tonnes of cane for the week, bringing the season total to more than 752,000 tonnes

CCS figures edged slightly higher by 0.01 of a unit over the previous week, to average 15.22 units.

This pushed the season to date CCS past 14 units for the first time this year, closing out at 14.02 units.

The highest CCS recorded for the week was 17.40 from a rake of Q240 PLT in the Dawlish productivity district.

There will be an 18-hour factory stop, commencing on Wednesday evening, to undertake a factory chemical clean before reinstating the No. 5 pan condenser.
