Plane Creek Mill crushed just shy of 46,000 tonnes of cane for the week, bringing the season total to nearly 800,000 tonnes

Factory operations stopped late on Wednesday night for planned cleaning and maintenance, and to enable crews to reinstate the No. 5 pan condenser.

Crushing resumed Thursday evening. By Saturday, the factory had settled and crush rates had significantly improved.

CCS edged higher by 0.23 of a unit over the previous week. The season-to-date CCS closed out at 14.10.

The highest CCS recorded for the week was 17.50 from a rake of Q208 PLT in the Cliftonville productivity district.

With school holidays continuing this week, we ask parents and carers to remind children about the dangers of playing on or around our cane rail network.
