Comments:

Plane Creek Mill passed the one million tonnes crushed milestone earlier in the week.

The mill has now processed 77 per cent of the total revised crop of 1.36 million tonnes.

Just over 61,500 tonnes of cane were crushed for the week.

This was a reasonable weekly throughput, given there was a 12-hour planned maintenance stop and a delayed re-start while crews finalised work on a prepared cane elevator.

Weekly CCS fell below 15 for the first time in six weeks, closing out at 14.93 units. The season-to-date CCS edged higher and settled at 14.35.

The highest CCS honour for the week was shared between a rake of Q240 1R from the Ilbilbie productivity area and a rake of Q183 Replant from the Westhill productivity area – both with a CCS of 16.8 units.
