#### Comments:

Plane Creek Mill achieved a reasonable throughput for the week with close to 66,000 tonnes crushed.

That brought the season-to-date total to just over 1.11 million tonnes, which represents 82 per cent of the forecast 1.36 million tonne crop.

There was a welcome improvement in CCS of 0.33 a unit over the previous week, taking the season-to-date CCS to 14.40 units.

The highest CCS for the week was 16.95 units from a rake of Q240 1R in the Carmila productivity district.

As we enter the final weeks of the 2021 season, members of the public are reminded to stay alert around our cane rail network.

Remember to approach all level crossings with caution and always give way to cane trains.
