#### Comments:

Just over 60,000 tonnes of cane was processed for the week, bringing the season total to more than 1.17M tonnes.

Isolated areas of rain impacted cane supply earlier in the week.

A full bin derailment immediately north of Yukan on the Koumala line disrupted operations for approximately eight hours on Friday.

Average weekly CCS was 14.96, down slightly from 15.26 the previous week.

The highest CCS for the week was 17.10 units from a rake of Q208 5R in the Dawlish productivity district.

As we approach the end of the 2021 season, motorists are reminded to use their 'train brain' around our cane rail network. Approach all level crossings with caution and always give way to cane trains.
