Comments:

Throughput for the week was below budget, due to ongoing challenges with wet field conditions and the factory settling back into normal operations.

Ground conditions are slowly improving, with harvesting groups putting in a good effort to source harvestable areas.

Although there was some unfavourable weather, the average CCS for the week was above budget at 13.24.

The highest CCS sample was 15.37 from a rake of first ratoon KQ228 in the Waterson Productivity District.

The Proserpine crop continues to cut above estimate and has been revised upwards to 1.7 million tonnes.
