Comments:

Showers throughout the district over the course of the week caused some disruptions to harvesting, culminating in a wet weather stop on Saturday.

Weekly throughput was restricted to just over 75,300 tonnes as a result.

The rain also impacted the average weekly CCS, which came in at 13.86 units, or 0.54 units below the forecast figure.

The highest CCS sample was 15.82 units from a rake of Q208 ratoon in the Gunyarra Productivity District.

As the crushing season has been under way for some time now, we would like to remind the community against complacency.

Never assume a section of rail is not being used, as our cane trains are regularly travelling to different areas depending on harvesting operations and maintenance requirements.

Our cane trains are working around the clock, seven days a week.
